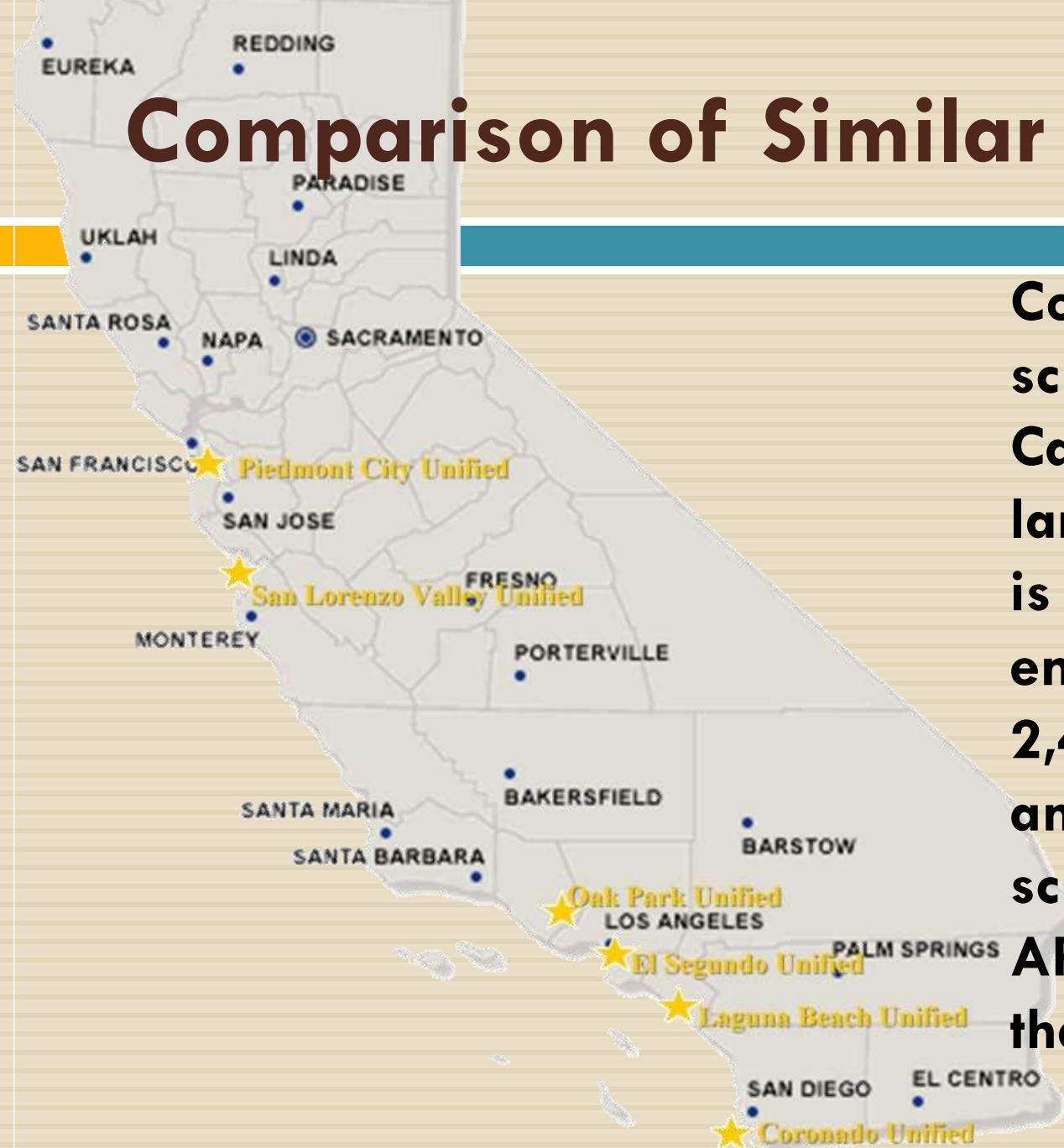

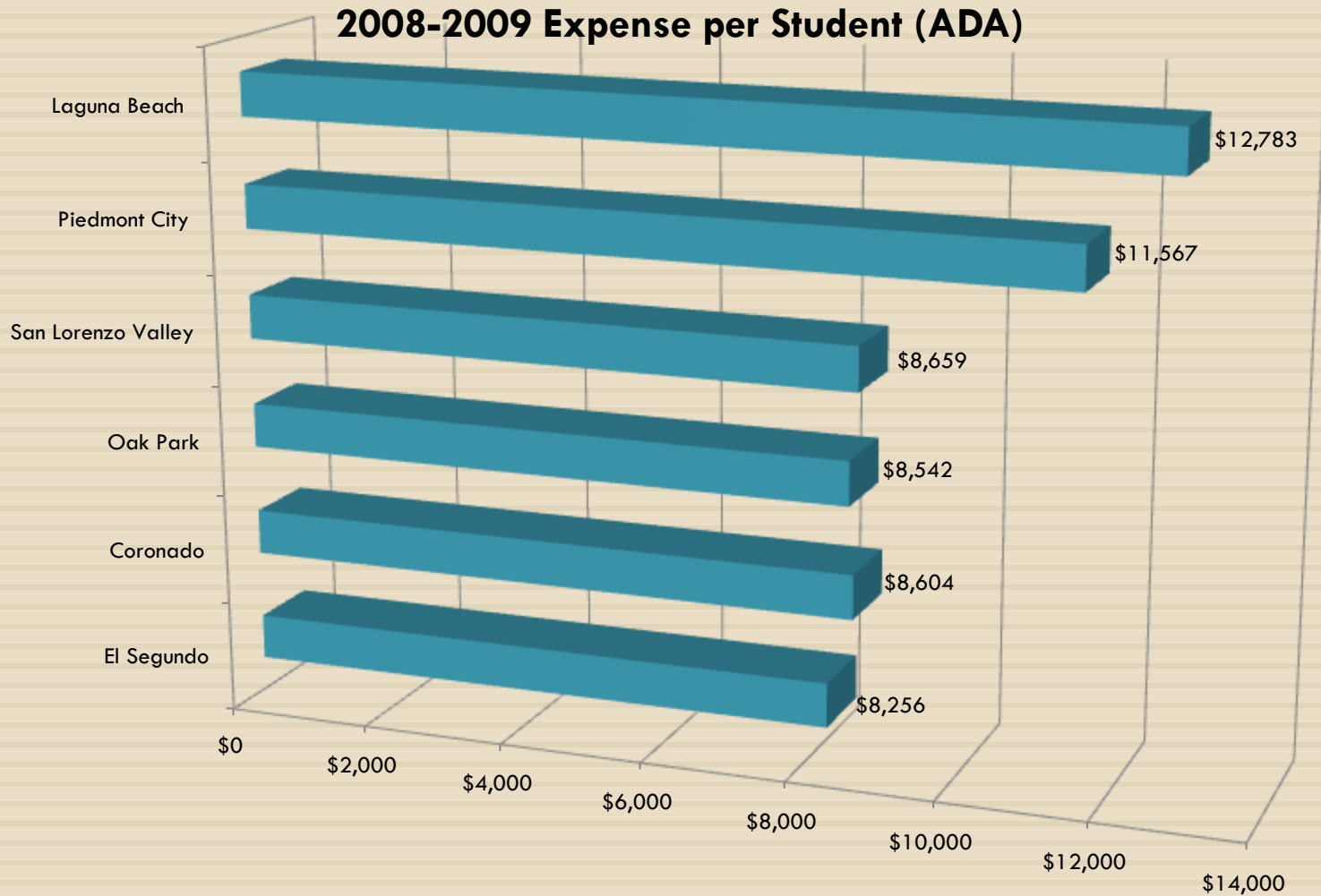

# Comparison of Similar Districts

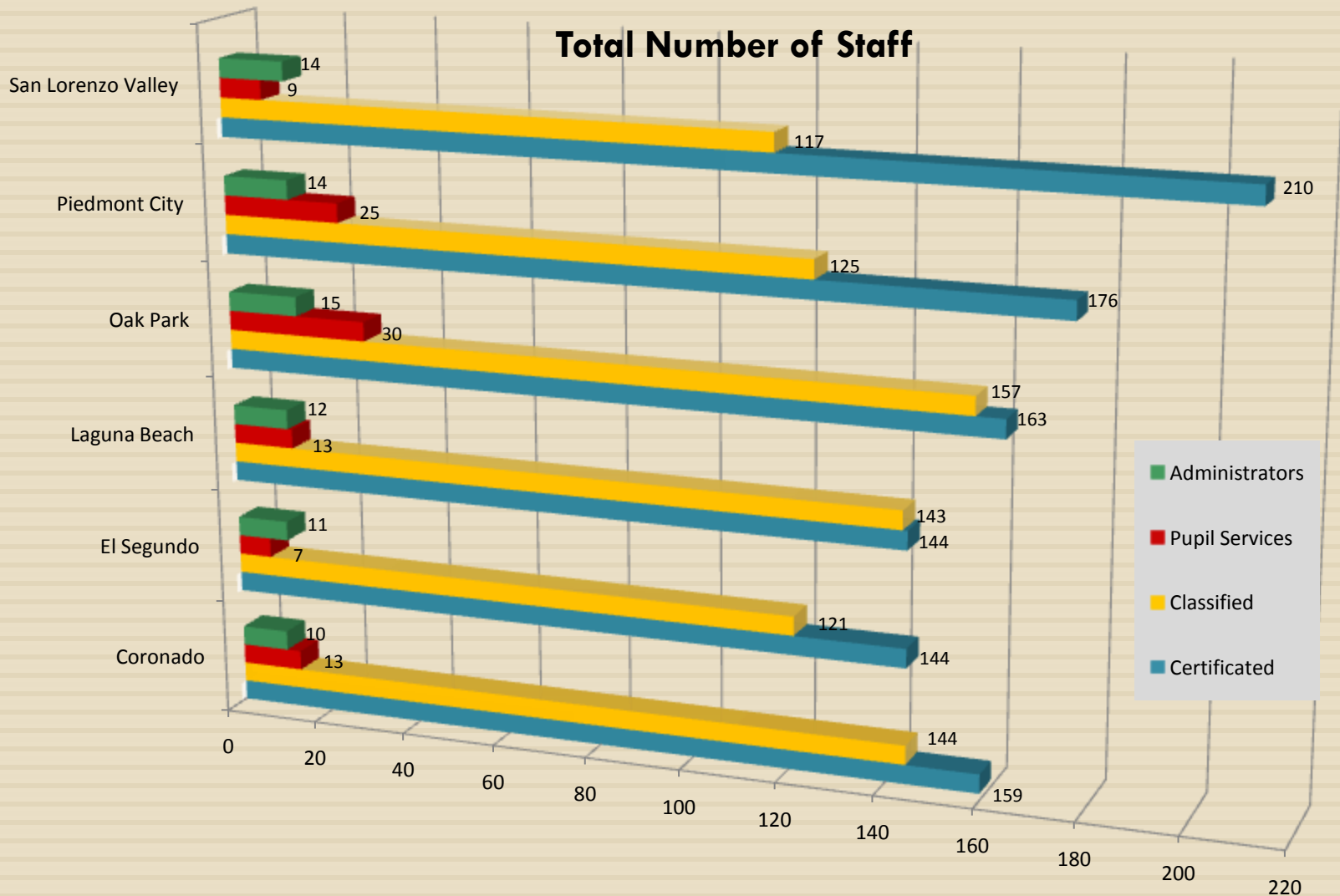
Compare all unified school districts in California, whose largest ethnic group is white, with enrollment between 2,400 and 3,600, and with district schools making API targets greater than 80%.

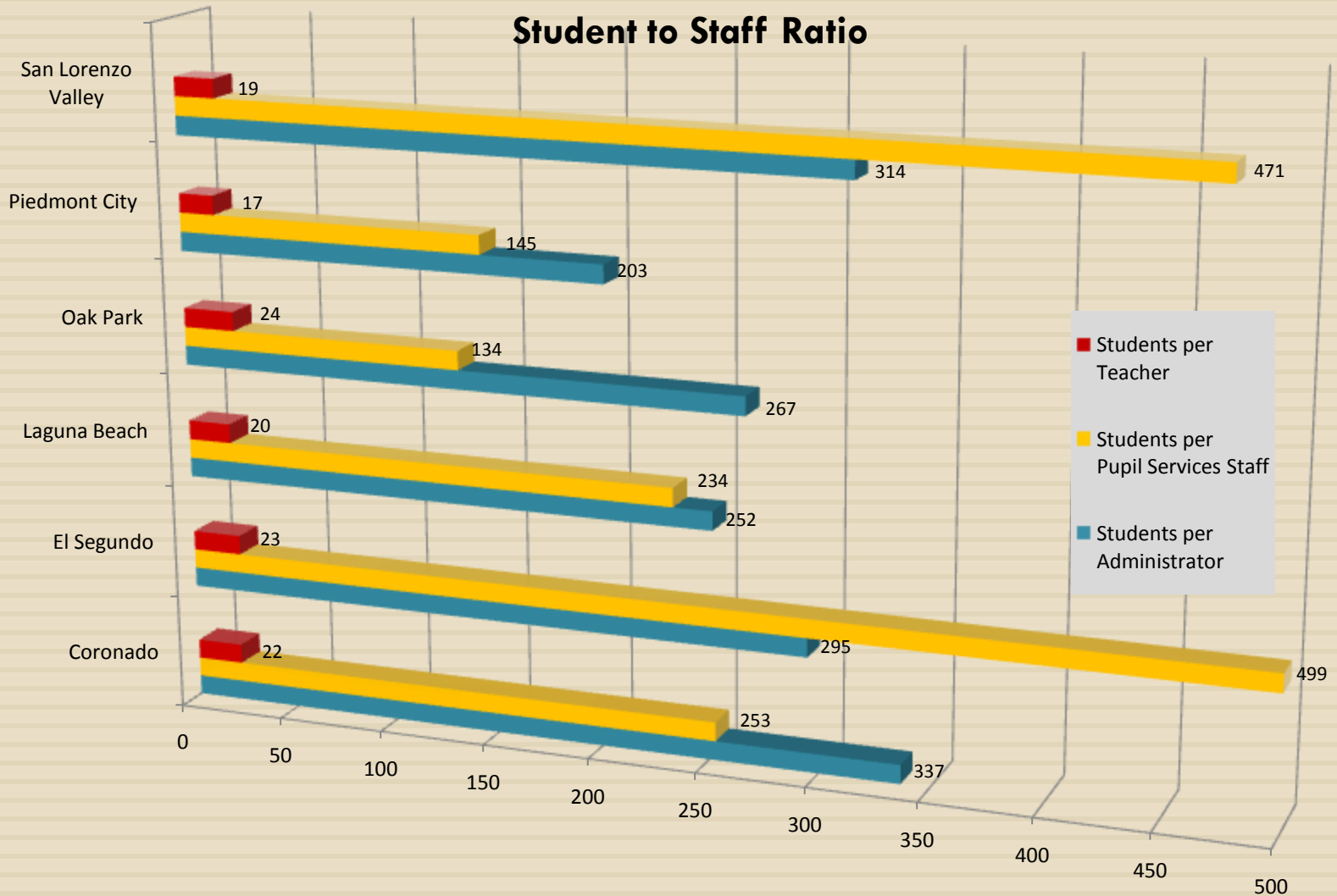

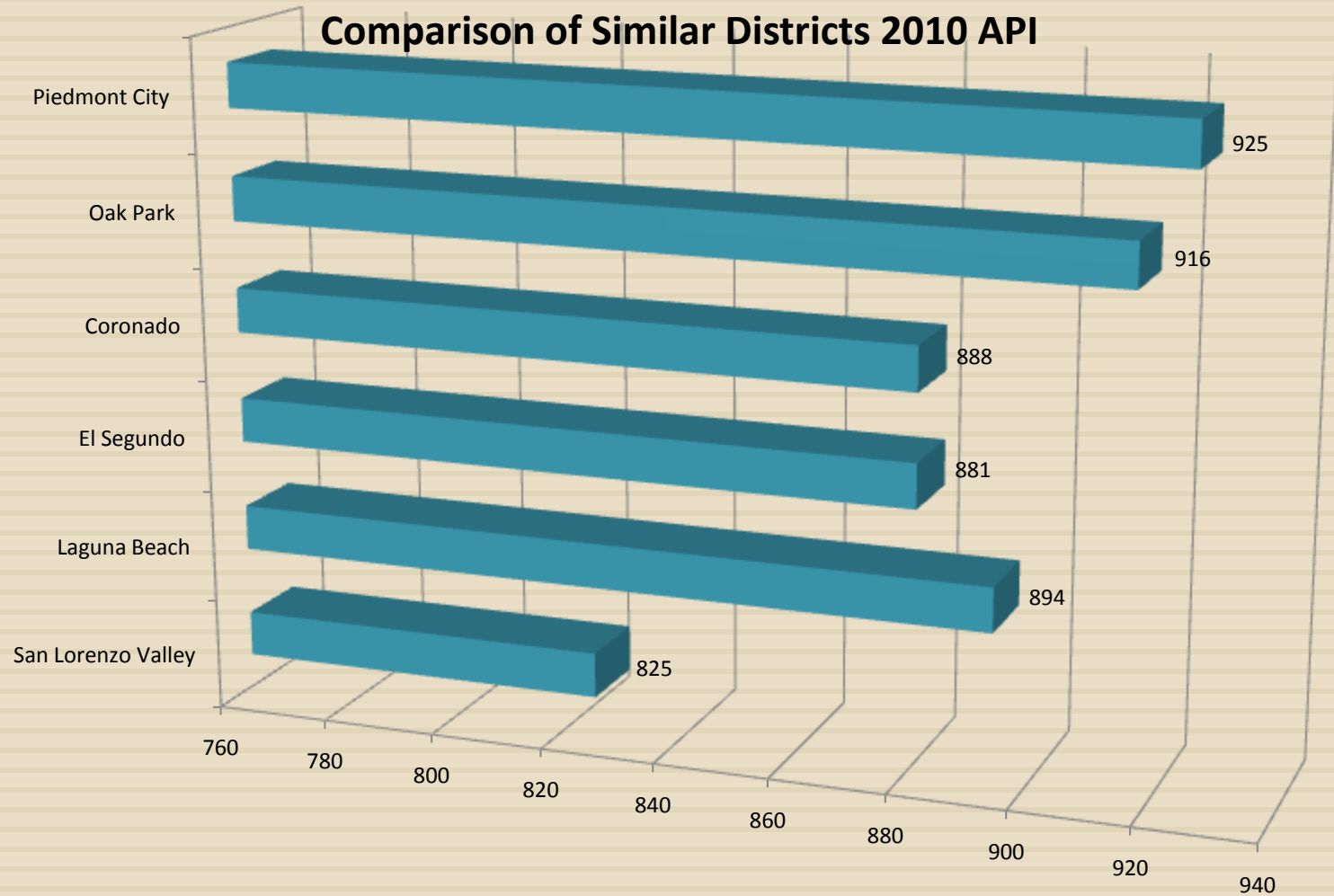

# California Compared to the Nation

- Nationally, there is one district-level administrator for every 761 students, in California the ratio is 1 to 2,366.
- California ranks 49th in the nation for its administrator to student ratio, with 1 principal or asst. principal for 447 students compared to the national average of 1 to 306.
- School leadership is second only to classroom instruction among all school-related factors that contribute to what students learn at school.

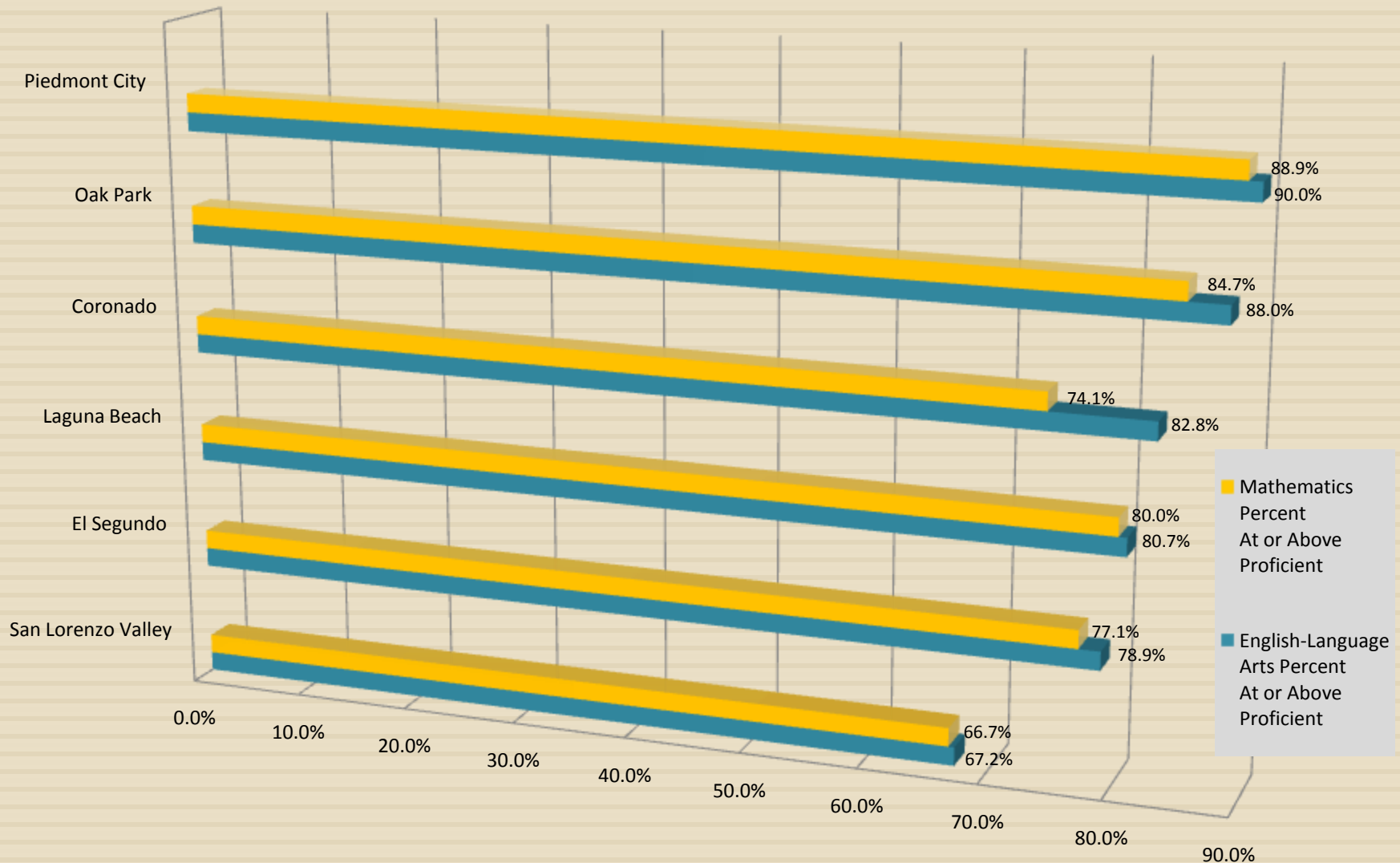

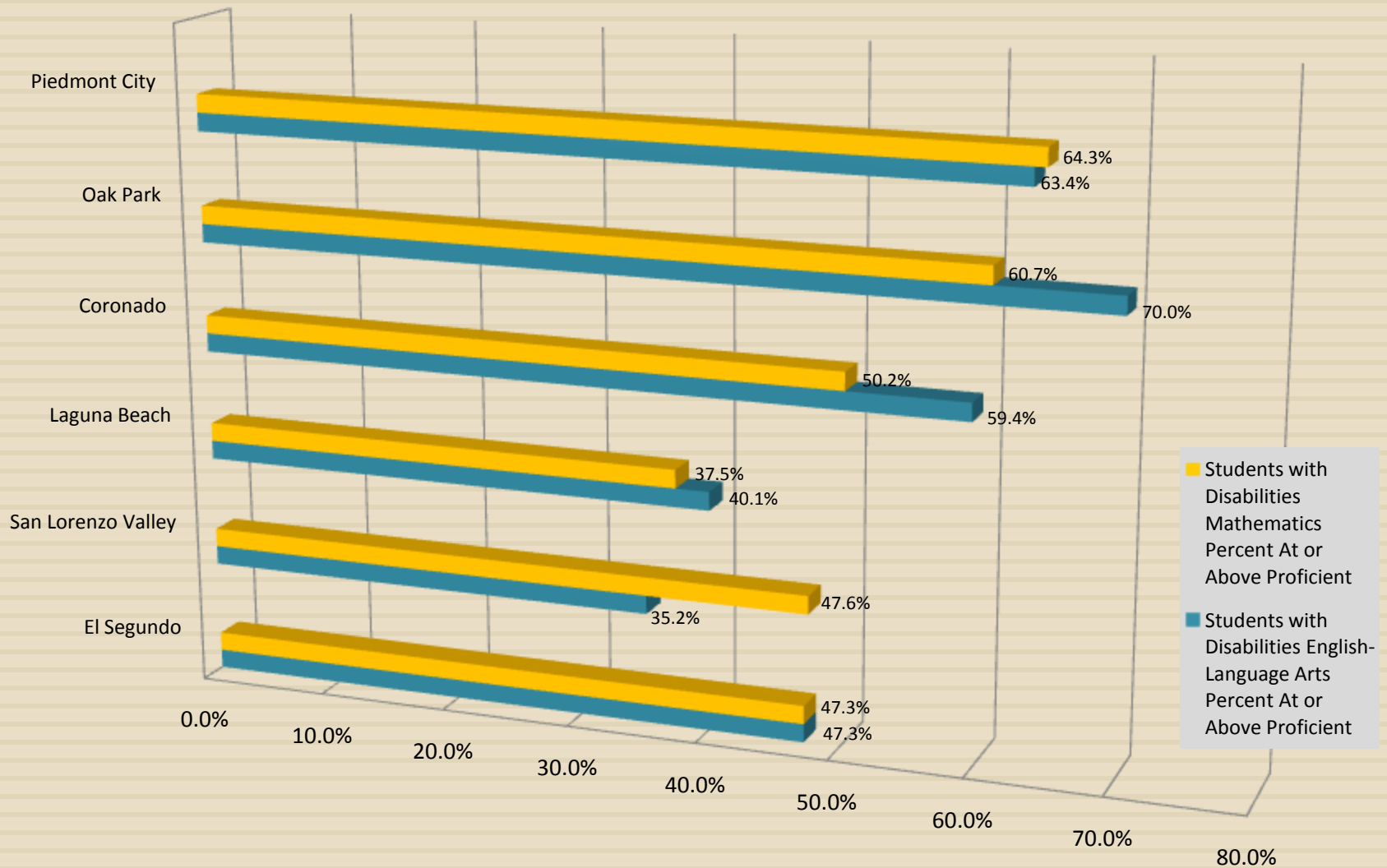
# Core Subject Comparison

## All Students 2009-10



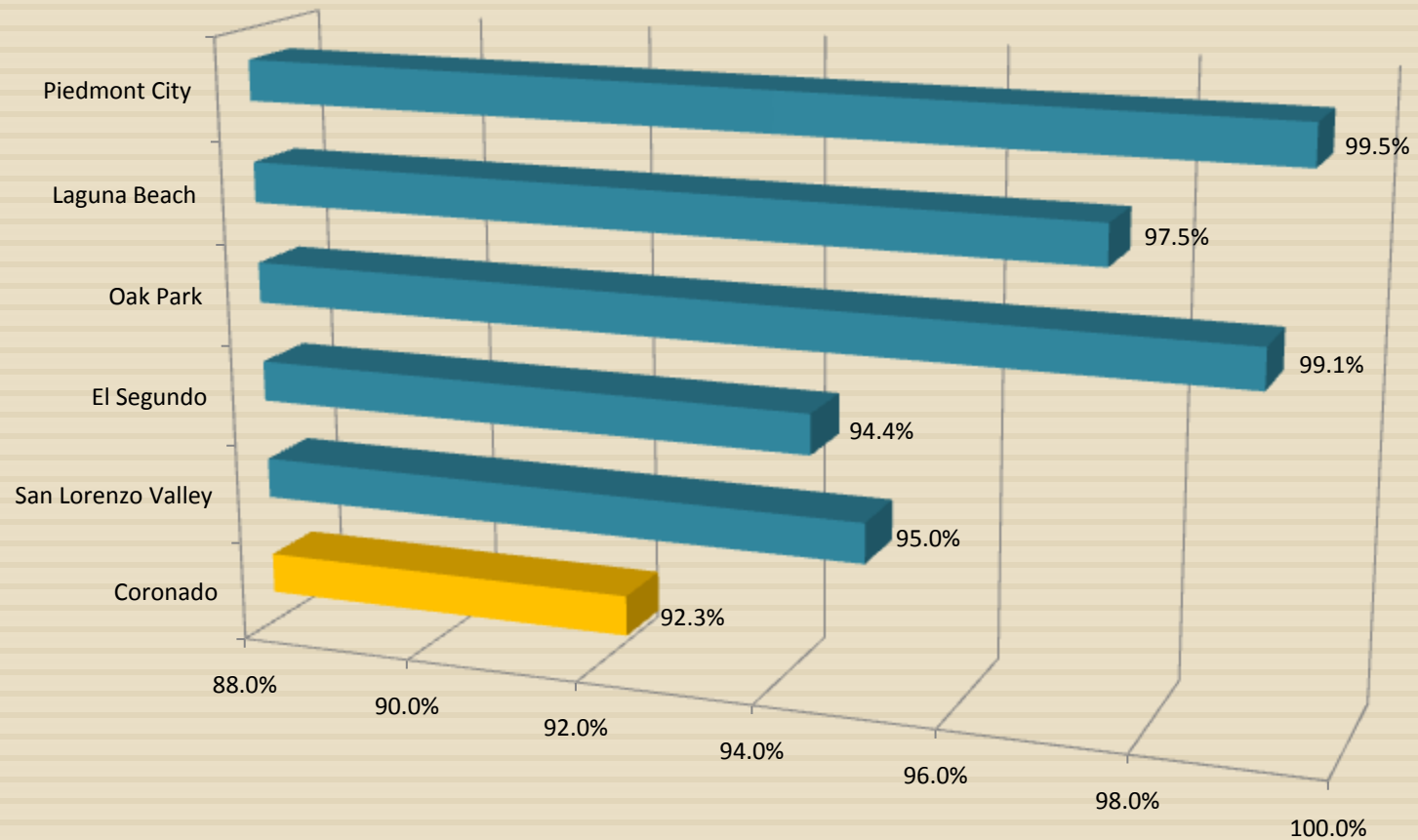
# Core Subject Comparison
