Addressing Health and Safety Concerns with Students**

Concern	How to Address	Follow Up
Student does not regularly use hand sanitizer or wash hands	Remind student of the importance of good hygiene. Allow student time to use hand sanitizer or hand washing stations.	Remind students regularly of good hygiene habits while onsite.
Student forgets mask at home	Provide student with a mask and remind them to bring a mask each day	If this becomes a regular occurrence, provide the student with several masks and contact the parent to see if they need assistance with obtaining masks for their student.
Student does not follow mask requirements and takes mask off without permission	<p>1st occurrence:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff member should remind student of the mask requirement and ask that the student put their mask back on. • Staff member should review with student how to ask for a mask break when needed. • Staff member should contact parent, via phone or email, to inform them of the occurrence and can share CUSD COVID19 Guidance and Reopening Information. <p>2nd occurrence:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff member will again remind student of the mask requirement and will inform the counselor and/or site administrator to discuss appropriate use of the mask with the student. • Counselor and/or site administrator will contact parent to inform them of the occurrence and that another incident could result in removal from onsite learning. • Discussion with student and parent should be documented in Synergy <p>3rd occurrence:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff member will send student to the main office to meet with the site administrator. • Site administrator will inform parent that student will need to transition to iAcademy due to student not following health/safety guidelines.
