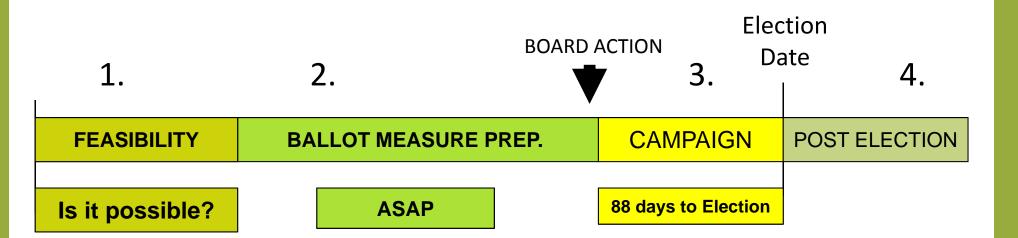

- CUSD cannot spend any resources to advocate (up or down) on the ballot measure.
- Neutral Information (FACTS ONLY) can be provided.
- Paid employees of CUSD may not advocate for/against the measure on "CUSD time". They may volunteer on own time.
