Chief Executive Officer (CEO) – responsibility for the daily operation of the company

Chief Human Resources Officer – oversees all human resource management and labor union relations

Chief Learning Officer – responsible for student academic success and staff professional development

Chief Communications Officer – head of communications, public relations, social media and/or public affairs within the organization

Chief Innovation Officer – responsible for seeding the future, identifying and exploring options for the district to develop new opportunities

Chief Compliance Officer – responsible for compliance in accordance to applicable laws, policy, and regulations

Deputy Superintendent

Chief Business Officer (CBO) – responsibility for the daily business operation of the company

Chief Financial Officer - responsible for the fiscal health of the district

Chief Technology Officer – primarily concerned with long-term and "big picture" issues

Chief Data Officer – the manager for enterprise-wide data processing and data mining

Chief Analytics Officer – overall responsibility for the analysis and interpretation of data

Director of Human Resources Chief Administrator for:

Director of Student Services Chief Administrator for:

Student assessments, consultation services, and psychological services Special education services including 504, SST, behavioral, and emotional support Health and counseling services including supervision of the district & school nurse(s)

Compliance with local, state, and federal regulations regarding special education, health, and counseling

Director of Special Programs Chief Administrator for:

Responsible to manage the daily operations of programs such as: School of the Arts (CoSA), Career Technical Education (CTE), and Preschool.

Develops an effective plan of action for running district programs and initiatives from inception to completion.

Leads the design, implementation, and evaluation of educational programs that promote and support the goals of grants.

Overlooks and maintains schools' accreditation and may coordinate activities within schools.
