As part of our plan to provide distance learning opportunities for all students during the COVID-19 health crisis, we will be utilizing Zoom a desktop and mobile device-based videoconferencing solution that includes interactive video, audio, screen sharing, chat and local recording features with usage that extends beyond public education. Zoom works on multiple platforms including Windows, Mac, Chrome OS, iOS, and Android devices. Zoom can be a helpful tool for conducting meetings, classes, holding office hours, or working with students off campus.

As part of the services Zoom provides to K-12 schools, Zoom may be used by students, including students under the age of 16. Zoom has signed the Student Privacy Pledge, signed the California Student Data Privacy Alliance Agreement, and has established a K-12 School District Privacy Policy designed to reflect their compliance with the requirements of the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act, the California Consumer Privacy Act, the Federal Education Rights and Privacy Act, and other applicable laws.

Coronado Unified School District is committed to providing a safe school environment, including during this time of distance learning. We have established an acceptable use policy designed to keep students safe online. It can be viewed at this link.

Please support us in this effort by monitoring your students' activity while online. This includes monitoring websites visited, apps downloaded or installed, and time spent online. National Online Safety offers these tips for parents on remote learning:

- Ensure your learning device is in a public space in the home
- Implement safety controls and privacy restrictions on apps and software
