Meeting began with recap of wellness goal SY 22-23 – reduction of single use plastic bottles by 50% district-wide.

- Amy Steward shared progress on previously assigned tasks:
  - Emerald Keepers marketing materials created and shared with the committee
    Discussion of flyer being sent in newsletters across district.
  - San Diego city banned single use plastics by July, CUSD can lead and hopefully Coronado city will copy
  - Sixteen high school students are focusing on trash and recycling at CHS. Looking into organic waste bins (compost buckets). Looking into a triad receptacle as well as looking at funding – maybe through a grant?
  - TikTok's focusing on recycling and what can be recycled (talked to EDCO who are not wanting to broadcast where our recycling goes)
  - Meeting with elementary school principals to share info and talk about class pledges and signage to be an "Emerald Keeper" classroom
- Donnie Salamanca shared:
  - o all staff lounges have been updated with filtered water and bubbly water.
  - Eliminating arrowhead contract/deliveries effective 02/08/2023
  - Asked Emerald Keepers to speak at February board meeting (we will meet as a committee before that meeting)
  - o Mentioned an "Earth Day" event centered around plastics and recycling.
    - Ideas included collection of Amazon boxes from the community and create a visual
    - Art installation of reused materials
- Kevin Ramirez shared:
  - Middle school garden was recently revamped
  - Middle school ASB will distribute posters and initiative
  - Focus on the education aspect as to "why" we need to recycle and not just "do it"
  - Loop in the service dogs as to why we need to eliminate food waste (service dogs on campus could pick up food being played with)
  - Discussion of "Science going on in the world" where the 6<sup>th</sup> graders study microplastics (how each person has about a credit card full of microplastics in your body)

- We need buy in from staff at staff meetings, versus one more thing on our plates
- All Members:
  - o Conversation about needing water at sports fields (softball and baseball)
  - Reviewed water refilling station numbers as of 11/1/22. The filters and numbers will be reset over the summer. At the end of the year, we will take readings and subtract the numbers received on 11/1. Discussion on one reader that was already at 36,000+ refills
