Did you know... that you could receive a citation (ticket) for not wearing your safety helmet while riding your bicycle, non-motorized scooter, skateboard, roller skates or inline skates?

- ♣ DO I REALLY NEED TO WEAR A SAFETY HELMET? Yes. It's the law!
- WHY ARE SAFETY HELMETS
 SO IMPORTANT? Bicycle
 helmets are for your safety and can
 reduce the risk of head injury by up
 to 85%. Most deaths related to
 bicycle falls and collisions involve
 head injuries. Wearing a helmet
 could save your life!

HOW CAN I TELL IF MY
SAFETY HELMET FITS
PROPERLY? The helmet should
fit comfortably and securely. It
should be worn so that it is level
on the head. The helmet should
not be tilted back on the crown or
pulled low over the forehead. You
should not be able to move the
helmet in any direction. The chin
strap must be securely fastened.
If needed, the helmet's sizing
pads can help improve the fit.
