Weed Control Round-up Spray Dates – All Sites - Thanksgiving Break, Winter Break, Spring Break, Summer Break & weekends as needed.

Fertilization Dates – All Sites - Thanksgiving Break, Winter Break, Spring Break, Summer Break & weekends as needed
