

# COVID-19: CUSD Response Timeline

## State and Local orders/guidance updates

San Diego County schools announced closures to prevent the spread of COVID-19

March 13

Per local public health order, schools permitted to reopen with Safe Reopening Plan.

June 12

Gov. Newsom orders schools in counties on the watchlist to operate via distance learning.

July 17

CDPH released updated [guidance](#) for schools..

August 3

SD County comes off the watch list.

August 18

Governor announces new [tier](#) system.

August 28

Schools allowed to [reopen](#).

September 1

CDPH: guidance related to [cohorts](#)

September 4

[Per CDPH](#): Schools not allowed to reopen if county moved to purple tier (unless already reopened).

September 17

Safe Schools for All [Hub](#)

January 14, 2021

## CUSD actions & response to State/local updates

CUSD Fall Task Force (FTF) is formed and begins meeting.

June 10

CUSD FTF develops three plans: Full, Partial, and 100% Distance Learning.

June 17

CUSD orders PPE, sanitizing and cleaning supplies for all sites and begins preparing facilities

July 1

CUSD FTF focus shifts to scheduling & continuing [BRIDGE](#) instruction while finalizing reopening plans

July 22

[CUSD school reopening plans](#) adjust to [guidance](#) for establishing [cohorting](#) as condition of reopening

August 31

Districts no longer required to take student temperatures

September 9

[CUSD Phase 1](#): First Cohort: Most vulnerable students

September 14

[CUSD Phase 2](#):

October 5

[CUSD Phase 3](#):

October 26

CUSD Self-Regulated by suspending On-Campus Activities due to staffing.
