SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Immunizations/School Physicals

New Students to the District, at all grade levels, per California law, must present a provider-documented immunization record. The record must show all required immunizations are completed. Students that who have never attended school in CA, who enter from out of state, are required to have Varicella (chicken pox) immunizations, or a provider-documented explanation that the student has had the disease. All incoming 7th-12th grade students must have proof of a valid Tdap vaccine prior to their registration for the 2016-17 school year. AB 354 states that no student may start school without this proof of vaccine. A current TB test is recommended at school entry but not required. All Transitional and Traditional Kindergarten/First grade students, at school entry, must present evidence of an official CHDP physical exam taken no more than 18 months prior to first grade, or up to 90 days after September enrollment.

High School Athletes

Prior to participating in athletics, each student must have on file in the High School Office, evidence of a physical examination or waiver and an insurance card. These forms may be obtained online at www.islandersportsfoundation.com.

Residency Verification

In accordance with State and Federal law each year, all students must present 2 proofs of residency in the Coronado Unified School District.
