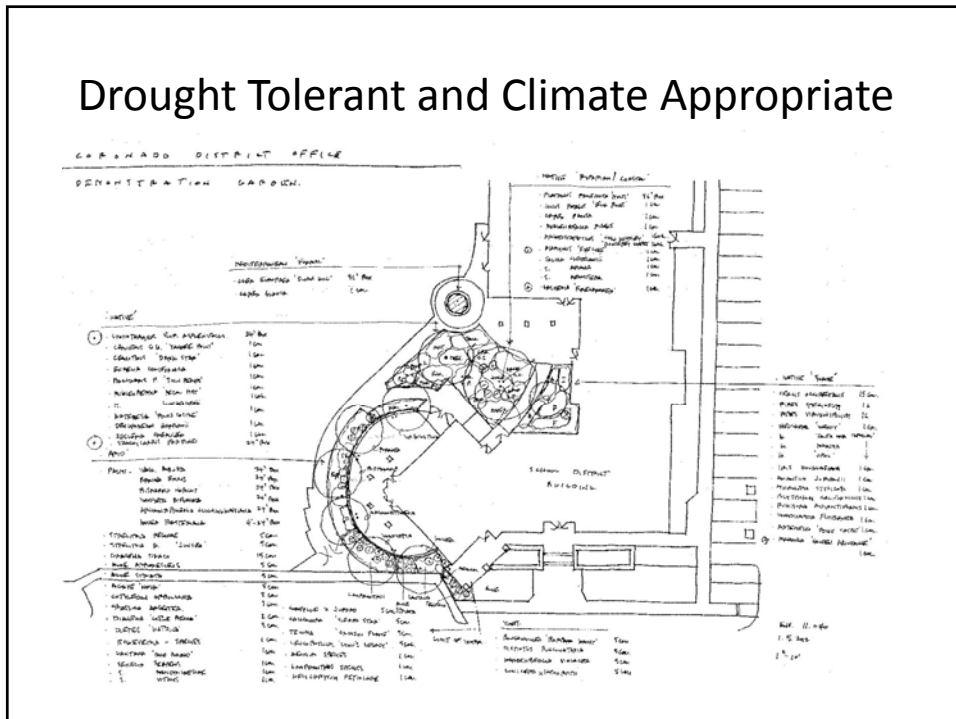

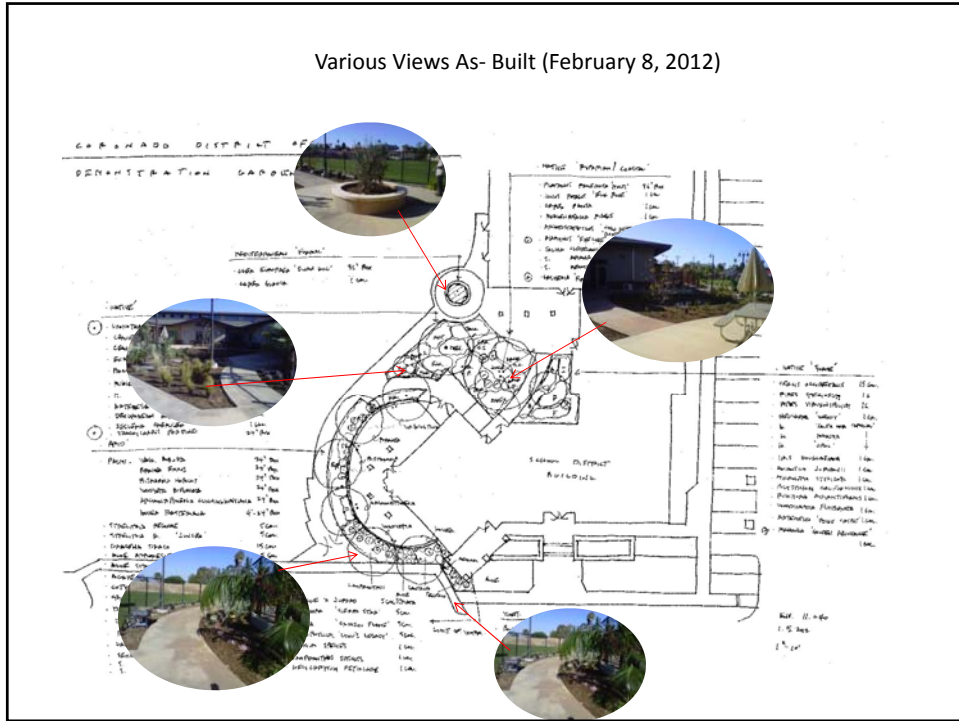
General Information

- Purpose: To provide a standardized landscape pallet for use in Coronado Unified School District Schools and Facilities
- Location: At District Office
 - 2,000 Square Foot interior court yard and entry west of the Board Room
- Storm Water Best Practices Observed
 - Drainage away from buildings
 - Ground Water Percolation via swales & channeling
 - Natural splash guards at down spouts to reduce erosion

Plant Materials

- Palms (7 types of palms; 7 trees)
- Plants (18 types of plants; 66 plants)
- Succulents (22 types of succulents; 146 plants)
- Vines (3 types of vine; 3 vines)
- Native Trees (4 types of trees; 4 trees)
- Native Plants (24 types of plants; 97 plants)
- Grasses (7 types of grass; 81 plants)
- Ferns (5 types of fern; 15 plants)

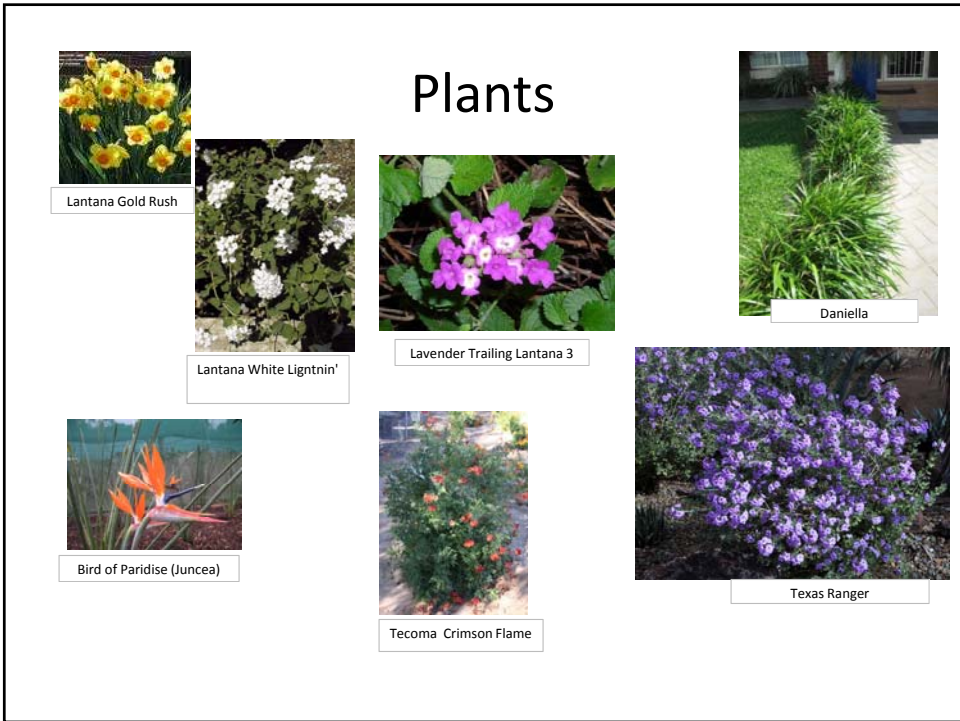
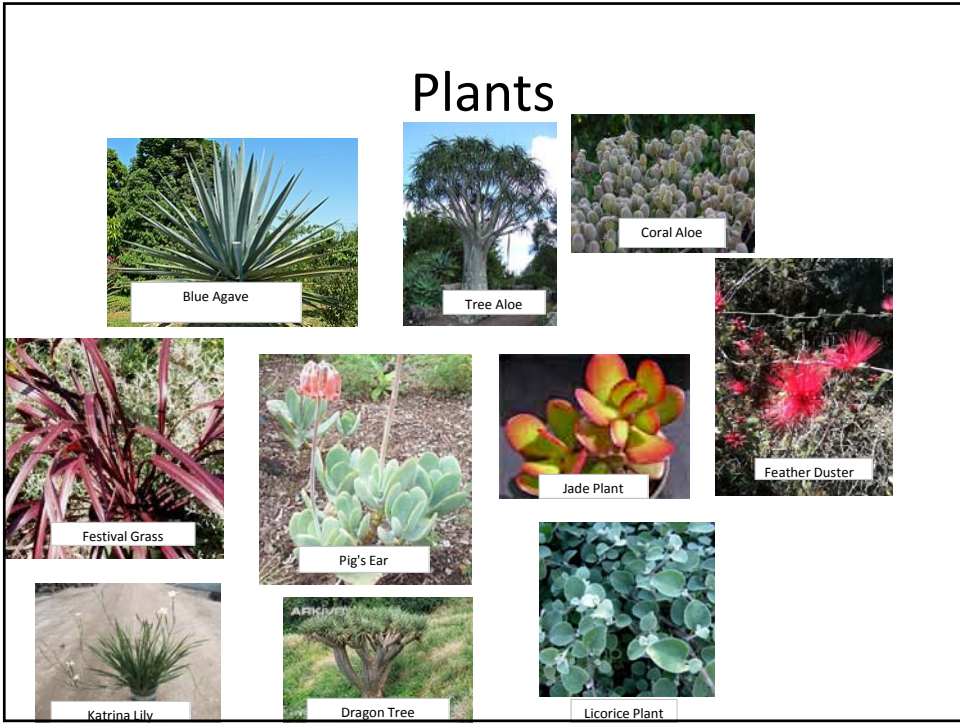
